Martin Luther King Jr. Library Updates

- Aging hot water/steam boiler heating system will be replaced in our beautiful downtown Art Deco style library
- Improvements will satisfy current energy codes, provide heating and air conditioning in the entire building, and create better ventilation
- City secured \$412,000 in 2022 state legislative funding for the upgrades
- Once updated, library can serve as cooling center and wildfire smoke relief center for community
- Projected completion date for upgrades – late summer 2023
