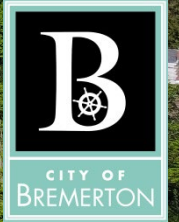


## Update on Kitsap Transit \*

We're pleased to share an update on what's included in the transportation budget for Kitsap Transit:

- Kitsap Transit is still in the transportation budget for the electric hydrofoil study
- Kitsap Transit received \$300,000 for the intra-county ferry feasibility study
- Budget included \$5 million (up from the request of \$1 million) to supplement Kitsap Transit passenger ferry service between Bremerton and Seattle

\* pending official legislative approval and governor's signature



## State Funding Update

### Salvation Army

- \$477,000 for Salvation Army. Joint City/County request to fund the 24-hr Shelter for 2 summer months



## State Funding Update

### Bremerton - Mason County Sewer Extension

- \$3 million for the Bremerton - Mason County Sewer Extension. Funds design to convey and treat sewerage from South PSIC to Mason County's Belfair Water Reclamation Facility
- \$1.7 million to Bremerton
- \$1.3 million to Mason County



## State Funding Update

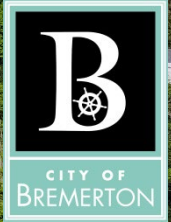
### Warren Avenue Bridge

Construction of the Warren Ave. Bridge multimodal project.

- \$15 million in 2025-27
- \$10 million in 2027-29

\$500,000 for Warren Avenue Bridge Design

- Funds contingent on the Climate Commitment Act funds continuing/Initiative 2117 failing



## State Funding Update

### View Ridge Safe Routes to Schools

- \$5.9 million for View Ridge Safe Routes to Schools. Design and construction of Phase 2; sidewalk and bike lanes on Almira Dr. from Ivy Rd. to Riddell Rd
- Funds contingent on the Climate Commitment Act funds continuing/Initiative 2117 failing

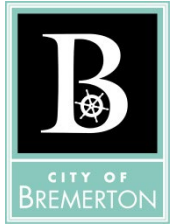


## State Funding Update

All Capital, Transportation & Operating budgets have been agreed to by the House and Senate and they will go off to Governor Inslee for his signature when the legislative session ends Mar. 7

# Biosolids Application Update

Shared by our Public Works & Utilities crew!



Our biosolids have been land-applied to Utility Lands since 1992. This sustainable disposal method improves forest health, and is low cost helping keep our utility rates the lowest in the region

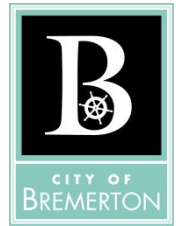
Truck 077, our current biosolids applicator vehicle, has been in use since 2000 and has become unreliable. A replacement vehicle was ordered in 2021.



After 3 years and a slough of supply chain issues, the replacement vehicle was delivered on Feb 27th!

The new truck is undergoing performance testing. It will transition into the position of lead applicator, and the old truck will be maintained as back up.

## **Bremerton Knights Boys Basketball**

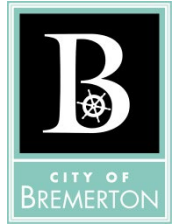
