Ford Lightning Service Vehicle

- This is the City's first all-electric service vehicle
- Learning what its capabilities are: This truck powered a 30-pound jackhammer for over an hour and only depleted 1% of its battery life
- The City currently has 5 EV's and 21 Hybrid vehicles in the fleet
- All new vehicle purchases are considered for potential EV or Hybrid



Washington Avenue & 11th Street Improvements



- Project includes widening of sidewalks, adding bike lanes, lighting, and stormwater and other improvements
- Temporary closure of 11th St and Washington Ave for construction – estimated to reopen by end of May
- A new roundabout will improve traffic capacity with reduction in delays - construction projected to begin June 2024 and will include 3 phases to limit closures and detours
- Project expected to be substantially complete by August 2024 with some additional work on lighting, pavement markings, etc.
