City Improvements for Charleston District



2024 Improvements

- Improved mid-block crossing at 600 block of Callow
- 3 planters relocated from Manette District
- 3 planters to be relocated from 4th Street
- 4 benches to be refurbished and then relocated from 4th Street

Future Area Improvements

- Wall prep will support Wycoff Ave mural painting at the Schoneman overcrossing – supporters launching fund raising effort for wall mural; City work has been pushed to 2025



Public Works Update - Pine Road Basin Stormwater Improvements Project



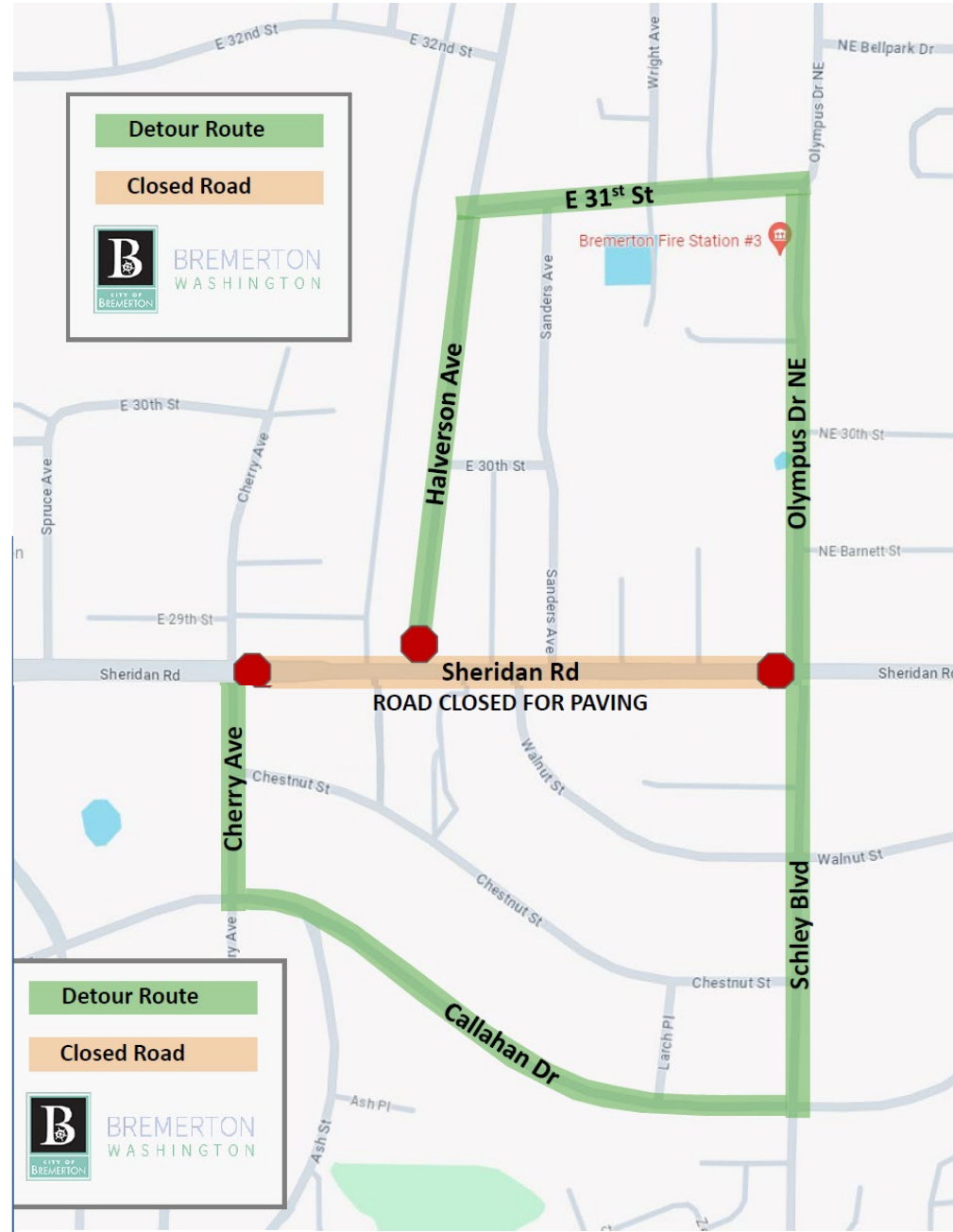
- Public Works Trust Board awarded an additional \$500,000 to the City for the project
- The City was initially awarded \$3.88 million in 2018
- Additional funding will cover increased costs caused by delays due to changes in federal permitting, COVID, and supply chain issues
- Construction of new storm sewer facilities in Robin and Eagle Avenues was completed late last year.
- Reconstruction of a marine outfall at Lebo Boulevard and Sheridan Road will take place this summer and complete the project.

Kitsap Lake Update

- The first Kitsap Lake algae control treatment will be completed on Monday, May 20 and Tuesday, May 21 from 8 AM to 5 PM.
- AquaTechnex will apply a treatment to the entire lake on Monday and Tuesday morning.
- Boaters are asked to stay clear of the application area so the treatment can be completed without interruption.
- Aquatic vegetation harvesting is scheduled to begin in late June through early July.
- A second algae control application is tentatively scheduled for late August
