Public Works Update: Parish Creek Fish Barrier Removal Project

- The Parish Creek culvert and fishway on W. Belfair Valley Road is listed by the state's Fish and Wildlife department as a complete fish barrier. It is the City's # 1 priority for stormwater culvert replacement.
- Removal and replacement with a bridge will provide fish passage and alleviate a flooding problem for the adjacent private properties and roadway.
- Nearly \$2.3 million in funding awarded. City match of \$566,500 (20%). Total project cost of \$2.83 million.
- Construction planned for 2027

- Completed signal and pedestrian safety improvements from Burwell Street to Riddell Road
- Received \$2.07 million in federal grant funding to implement an adaptive signals pilot project on Wheaton Way

Upcoming priorities

- Complete design and construction of Warren Avenue Bridge Multimodal Project
- Implement Adaptive Signals on Warren Avenue
- Install Mid-block Pedestrian Crossings at several locations
