Dr MLK Way Sidewalk Replacement Project

Work Plan includes:

- Removing 375 feet of old sidewalk
- Replacing with a 9-foot sidewalk to match West end of street at Warren Ave.
- Posting No Parking signs during duration of work from July 8 to July 19, 2024; signs will be placed before work begins
- Work will be done in 2 phases, using fence panels to protect new sidewalks
- Daily road closures of Dr MLK Way are possibility to maximize efficient work



Manette Bridge Cleaning and Maintenance Starting Soon!

Crews will be out pressure washing and performing vegetation control before we paint the sidewalk barriers in late July





Quincy Square – 405 Wash. Ave Garage Mural

- Work has begun to prep the parking garage at 405 Washington Ave for installation of the Quincy Square mural
- Crews have removed damaged plexi-glass window panels and are enclosing window openings
- A skim coat will be added to ensure a smooth painting surface for the muralist



Washington Ave & 11th Street Roundabout Construction Upcoming Temporary Traffic Impacts



New traffic impacts starting **Monday, July 8** (Estimated 3 - 4 week duration)

Daytime (8:30 am – 2:30 pm) weekday closures of **northbound** Washington Ave between 6th St and the Manette Bridge will be required

Detour will be provided; **Local Access Maintained**
