2024 Kitsap Lake Management

Bremerton treats Kitsap Lake twice a year for phosphorus to manage water quality and control algae blooms within the lake. Once per year aquatic plants are harvested from the lake to minimize aquatic weeds and manage the lake plant populations.

These treatments have been occurring since 2020 and have resulted in a cleaner lake that is open to recreation year-round. Managing Kitsap Lake optimizes water quality in the watershed and promotes more natural lake and watershed functions.

For 2024:

- The first Eutrosorb-G phosphorus treatment occurred in May
- Aquatic weed harvesting will begin in August, starting this week.
- The second Eutrosorb-G treatment is scheduled to follow the aquatic weed harvest in the middle of August

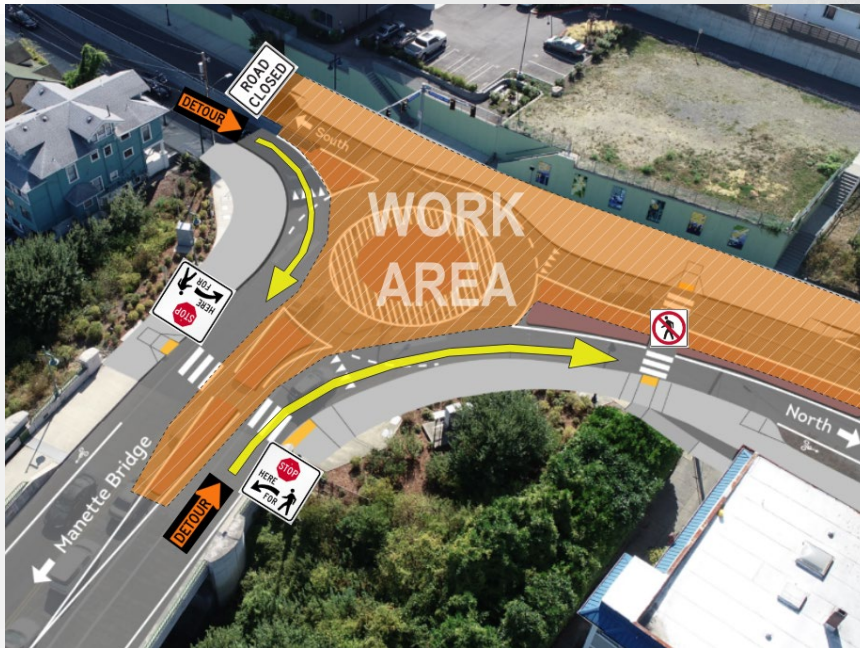
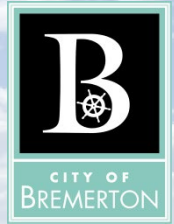


Aquatic Weed Harvesting Activities

Roundabout completion anticipated in **late August**

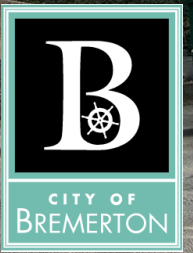
