

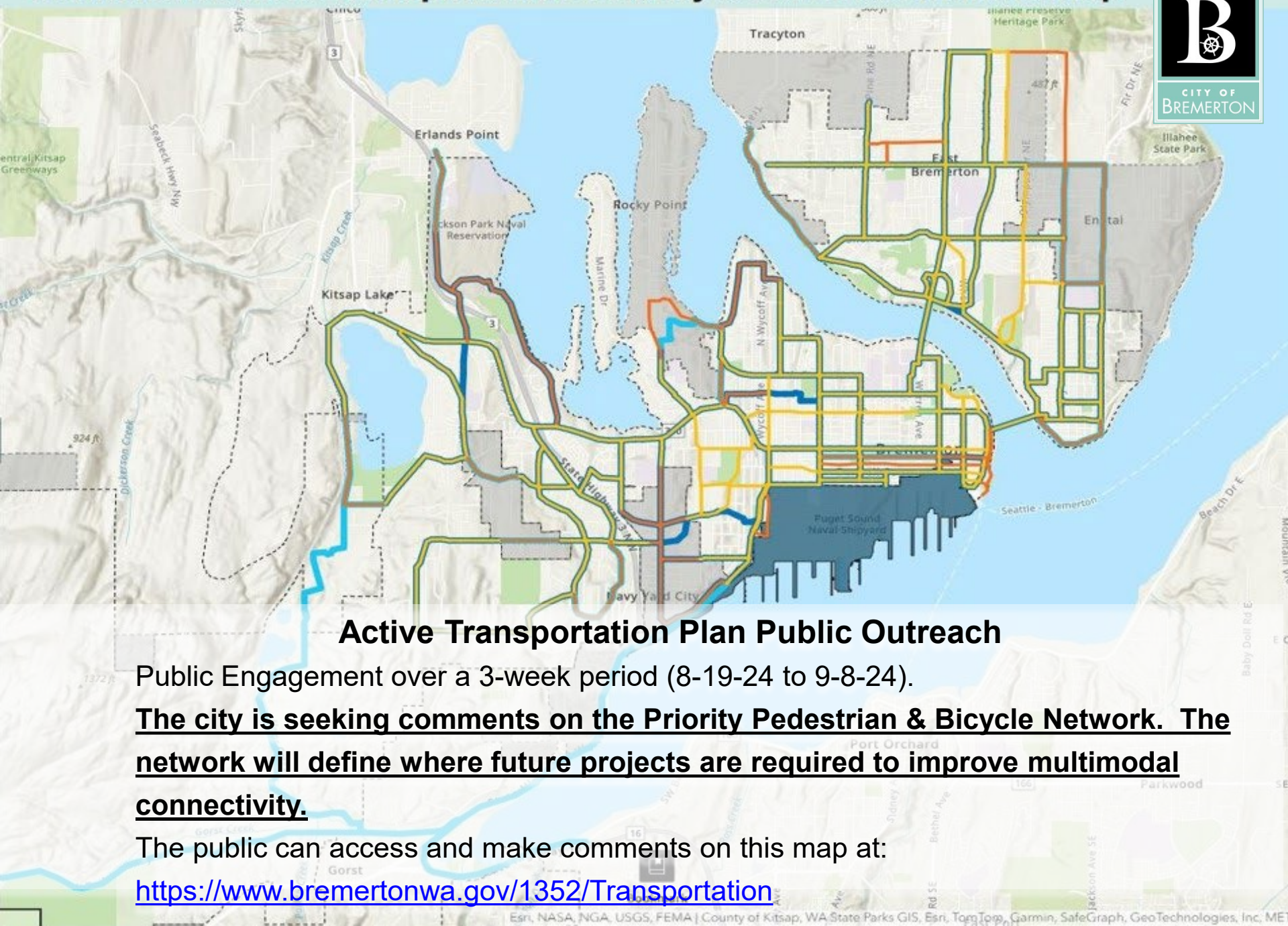

Defense Community Infrastructure Program Grant (DCIP)

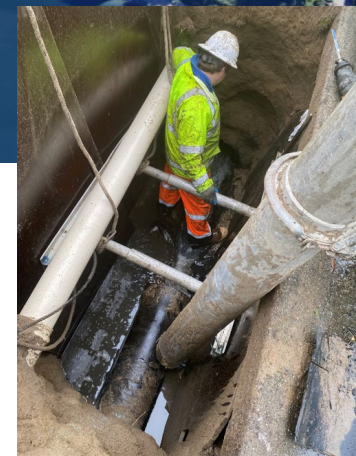
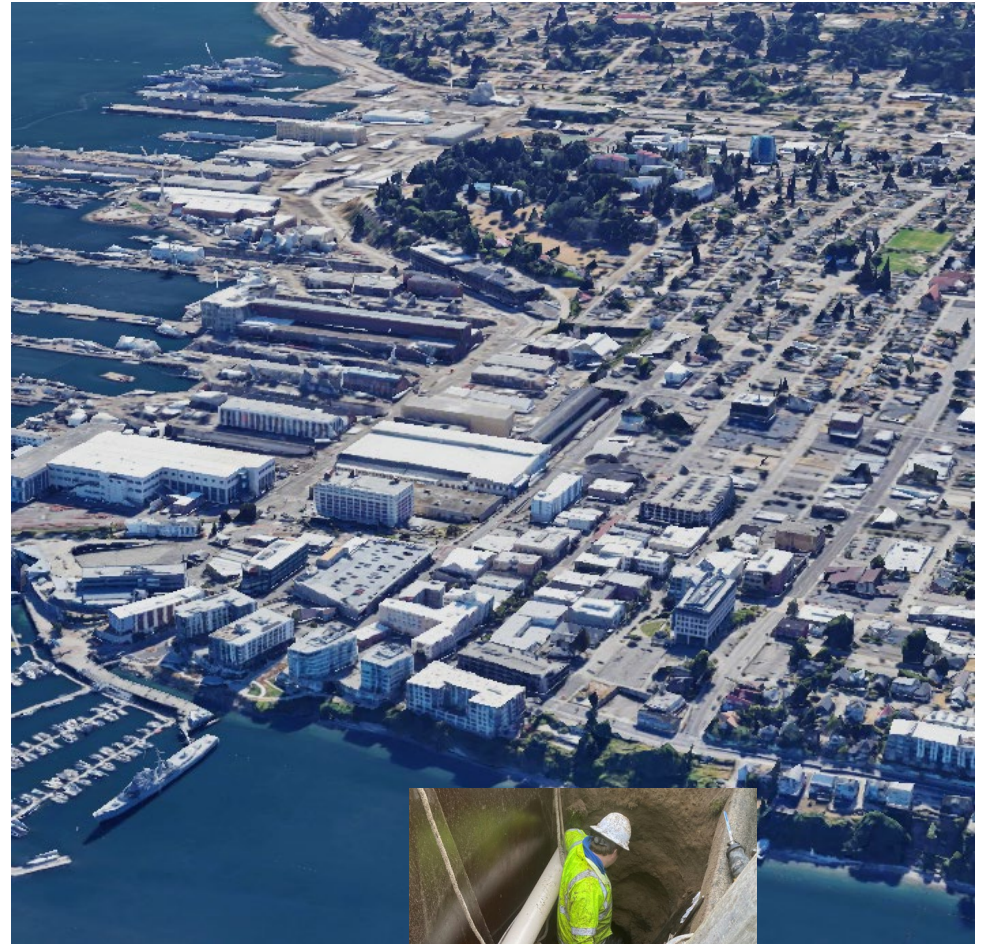
In June, staff submitted a \$7.2M grant application to replace 3,100-ft of the Central Bremerton Forcemain that failed earlier this year.

We have been notified that of the 114 applications submitted, ours ranked 5th, which allows the City to move to the next phase to secure this funding.

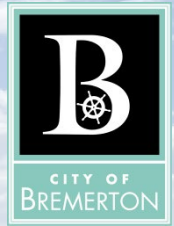
Staff are working with Office of Local Community Cooperation (OLDCC) on the grant which is scheduled to come to Council in September for Council approval.

DCIP is a new program that allows Dept of Defense funds to be spent on municipal projects with mutual benefits.

This grant will help keep Bremerton's utility rates the lowest in the region.



Washington & 11th Street Improvements Upcoming Final Street Paving



Final asphalt paving along Washington Ave and 11th St (including the roundabout) is planned to occur on **August 26 & 27**

There will be significant traffic delays and local detours during the 2-day paving operation

Traffic is encouraged to use the Warren Ave Bridge as an alternate route. Expect delays if traveling on 11th St, Washington Ave, or the Manette Bridge

Gorst Creek Fish Weirs

- Each year PW&U installs temporary fish weirs to overcome fish barriers on Gorst Creek. Weirs were recently installed on August 9.
- Partnership under development with Suquamish Tribe to study/design improvements to eliminate fish barriers and need for temporary weirs
- Future construction will also remove obsolete concrete channels in areas - will construct a more natural stream channel for creek and protect existing structures
- Suquamish Tribe has secured funding with plans to begin feasibility study this fall
