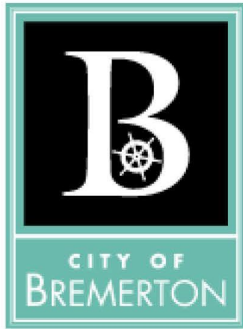

Washington Ave Bike Lane

Ordinance #5499 to amend BMC Section 10.070 entitled Parking Violations was passed on September 18, 2024.

Action

Since passing, Load/Unload Zone signs have been removed and replaced with No Parking signs

Traffic delineators have been installed to prohibit parking in the area.

Streets/Traffic division will check daily to ensure delineators properly placed and not removed

Future

Next spring, City staff will construct a new curb and gutter and fill in the sidewalk to align with adjacent sidewalk.





USS Bremerton Memorial

- USS Bremerton memorial would be located near PSNS and on current property of Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT)
- Recently received agreement from WSDOT allowing City to construct and maintain Navy memorial on the property
- WSDOT is working to initiate a transfer of the property to City of Bremerton in future
