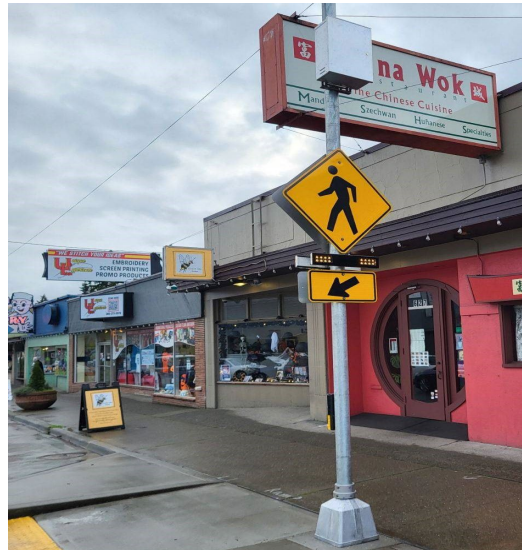

 - Installing new flashing beacons with pedestrian-scale lighting for improved pedestrian safety

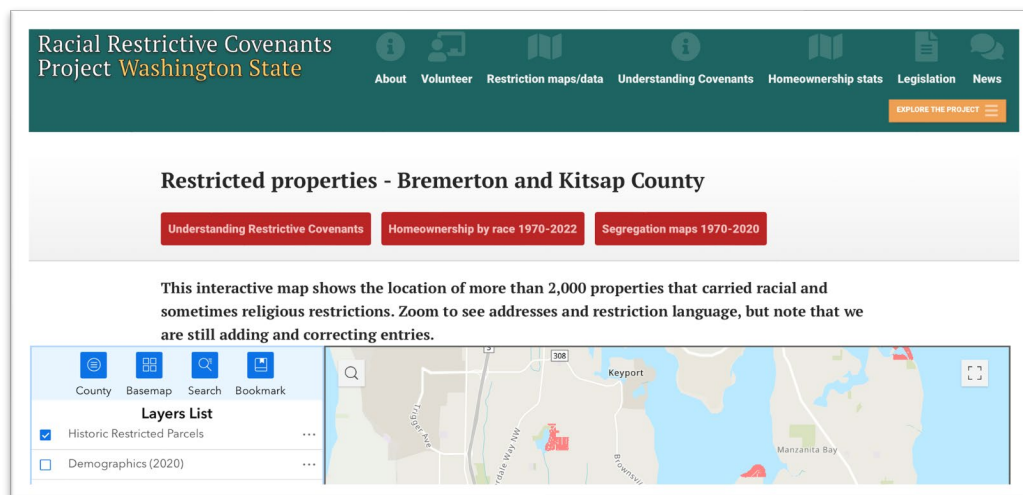
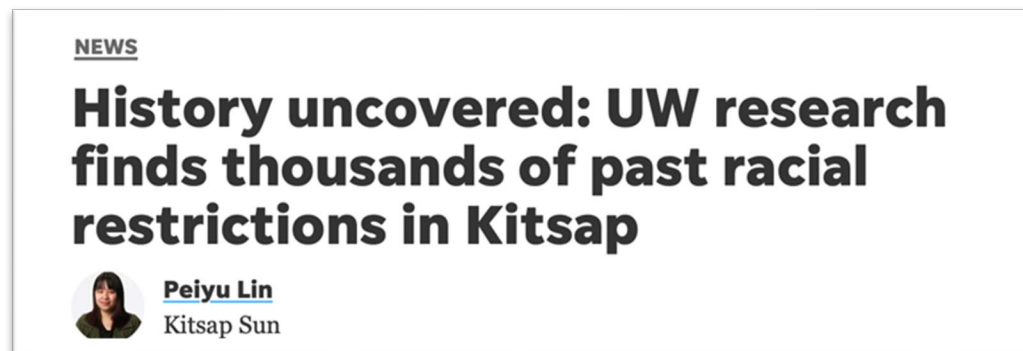


Racially Restrictive Covenant Removal



- In the first half of the 20th Century, racially restrictive covenants were recorded on some property in Washington State, including Bremerton and Kitsap County
- While these covenants are not valid or enforceable, Washington State has amended its law against discrimination to provide property owners a new way to strike racially restrictive covenants
- The City of Bremerton has highlighted what property owners can do to remove these restrictive covenants through the Kitsap County Auditor:
