Wycoff Wall Underpass Prep and Paint



City of Bremerton staff and contractors recently completed the prep and paint of the Wycoff Avenue underpass to make it ready for an art mural that the Charleston Business District will install in the near future.

Work performed includes:

- Repairs to the road, sidewalks and fences
- Pruning trees and vegetation control
- Minor concrete repairs to the overpass facade
- Caulking of expansion joints for a seamless look for the art mural
- Pressure wash underpass walls and beams
- Prime and paint both walls and outer beams

WSF Restoration Update



- Today, WSF announced an updated Service Contingency Plan, which details service restoration as well as how WSF will respond to unplanned service disruptions. One important update to note:
