Quincy Square Interpretive Signage

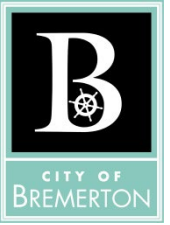
Proposed Off-Leash Dog Area Survey

Central Bremerton Force Main (CBFM) Replacement – Project Update



- The Central Bremerton Force Main serves east half of Puget Sound Naval Shipyard and downtown
- City discovered 3,100 feet of pipe needed to be replaced due to corrosion
- City identified and was awarded \$7 million in federal grant funding for construction; \$600,000 for design from City funding
- Construction started in July 2025; pipe was replaced and placed into service in mid-November
- Pipe sized to meet future demands for Bremerton Shipyard and downtown Bremerton
- City coordinated with U.S. Navy, Puget Sound Energy, Comcast, Waste Management, and residents in area to ensure minimal impact to public

- City Parks Department and Public Works crews worked together this afternoon on placing a tree in Quincy Square for the Downtown Business Association's Winter Fest
- The tree will be lit up for the Winter Fest event on Sat., Nov. 29!
- 20-foot tree was donated by Bacon Tree Farm
- This year's Winter Fest includes the tree-lighting ceremony, Santa's Workshop, holiday shopping market, live performances, and all-age activities
