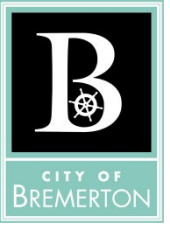

- **School zone safety improvements**, including updated signage, speed feedback signs and flashing beacons

- Crownhill Elementary School
- John D “Bud” Hawk Elementary School
- Mountain View Middle School
- Naval Ave Elementary School

Community Benefit:

- **Traffic calming** to slow vehicles near schools
- Improved visibility and driver compliance in school zones
- A visible investment in neighborhood livability and school access



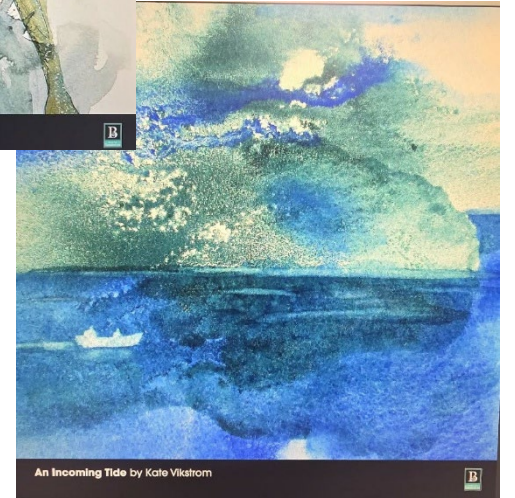
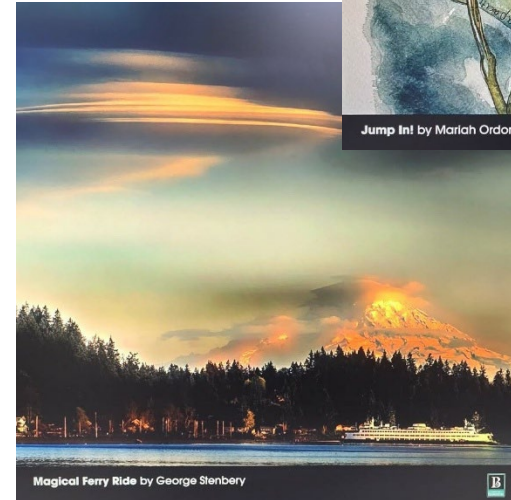
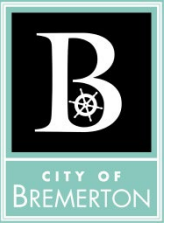
Speed feedback sign installed near John D. “Bud” Hawk Elementary School

- Potential improvements include walking path, covered shelter, hydroseeding, improved fencing, and added amenities
- City and partners continuing to confirm funding levels, develop a project timeline, and identify additional support needs
- Updates to be provided as plans and funding are finalized
