The City of Bremerton has dedicated nearly \$1.4 million in COVID-19 CARES Act funding to support residents, businesses, and the City's school district.

Bremerton Rental Assistance Program

Grants to tenants to make rent payments during COVID-19

Round 1 - \$268,383

Round 2 - \$265,048

Total Funding to Rental Assistance Program = \$533,431

Small Business Assistance (SBA) – Bremerton CARES

Business grants for rent and lease payments, etc.

Phase I & II - \$137,258 awarded to 29 businesses

Phase III - \$443,319 awarded to 57 businesses (new and previous awardees)

Total SBA Funding = \$580,578

City of Bremerton Partnership with Bremerton School District

Mobile Bus Hotspots - \$29,777

Mobile T-Mobile Hotspots for 150 students - \$39,240

Touchscreen Tablet Computers for 450 students - \$183,933

Total Funding to Bremerton School District = \$252,950
