CITY SNOW AND ICE PROCEDURES

Level 1 – Frosty Morning

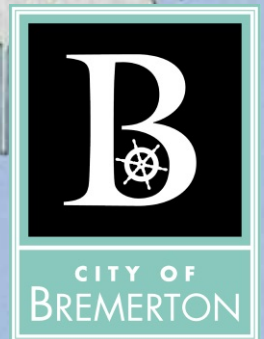
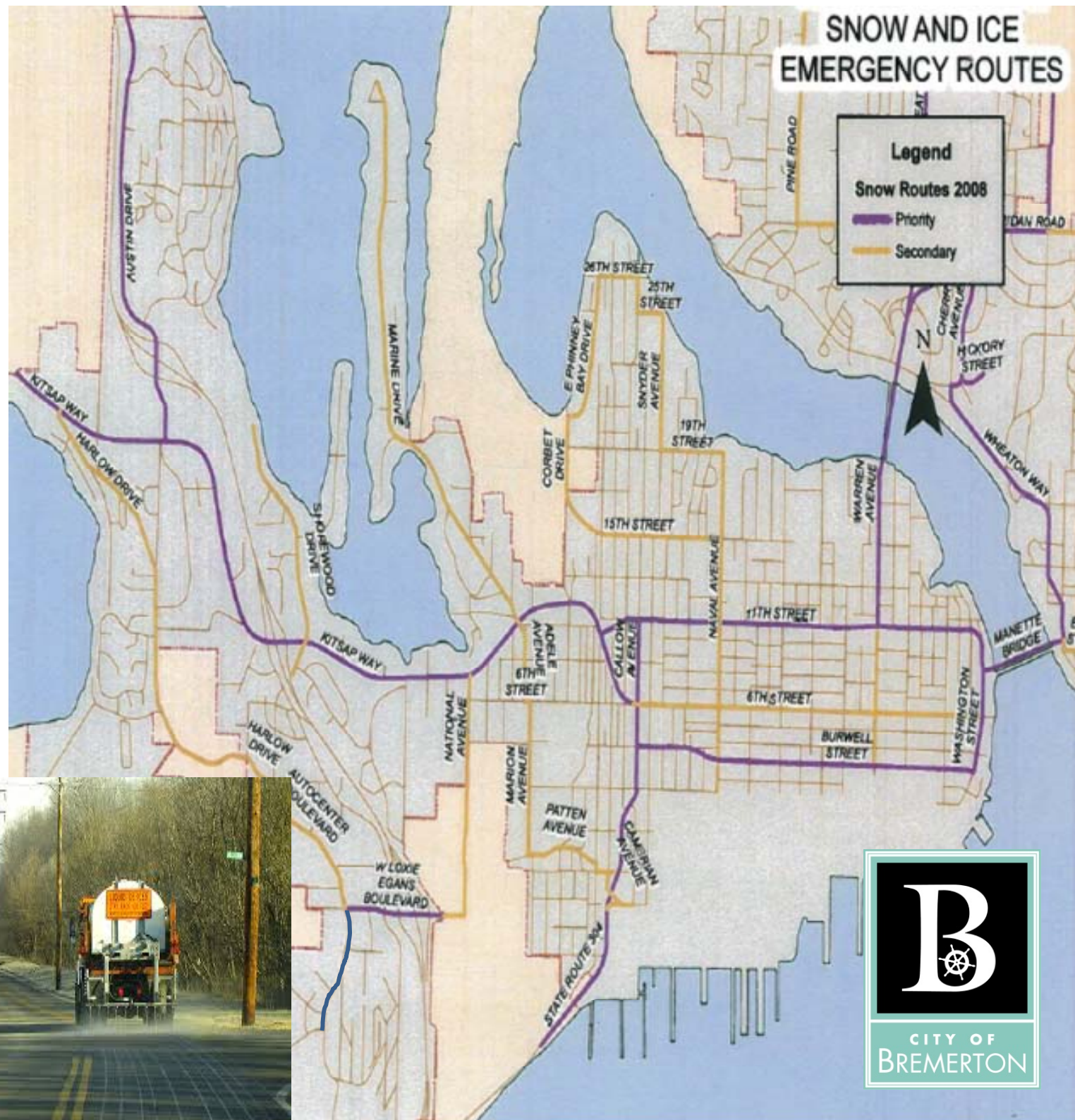
- Limited salt brine and sanding (bridges, arterials, hospital, other problem areas)

Level 2 – Extended Freezing

- Expanded salt brine and sand

Level 3 & 4 – Snow

- Sand and salt brine before
- Plow snow routes
- Clean-up afterward
- 12-hour shifts/24-hour operations



February Snow Events

February 8th – 15th 2019



City Priorities for February Snow Event

Priority 1 Roads

- Main Arterials to Hospitals / Emergency Access
- 60 Lane Miles
- Plowed several times throughout events

Priority 2 Roads - Secondary

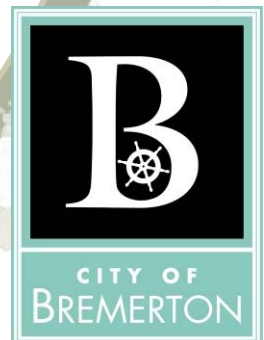
- Main Arterials and Connectors
- 35 Lane Miles
- Plowed several times throughout events

Residential Roads

- 80% plowed by Thursday Night
- 192 Lane Miles

Total Service Area Roads

- City Limits, Extended City Limits (Anderson Hill COB Developments, Lake Flora Rd, Old Belfair Hwy, Barney White)



Snow Shift 2/8/19–2/14/19 (Fri-Thurs)

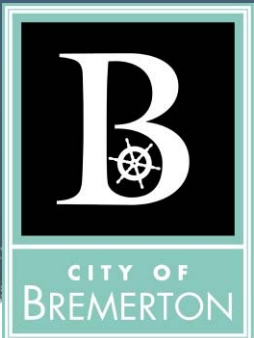
- Two 12-hour shifts daily (24-hour coverage)
- Noon to Midnight & Midnight to Noon
 - 10 - Street Department Personnel
 - 4 - Equip. Services Personnel
 - 4 - Admin
 - 7+ - Personnel from other Depts.
- Each Shift had 7 plows/Operators
 - Three plows with Salt Brine
 - Four plows with Sand

Snow Shift 2/15/19 (Fri)

- Regular Shift
- Continued to receive calls/assess conditions and respond to residents' plowing needs

Totals

- 10,000 Gallons of Salt Brine
- 700 Tons of Sand
- 70 Work Orders for Equipment Repair
- 396 Phone Calls Answered





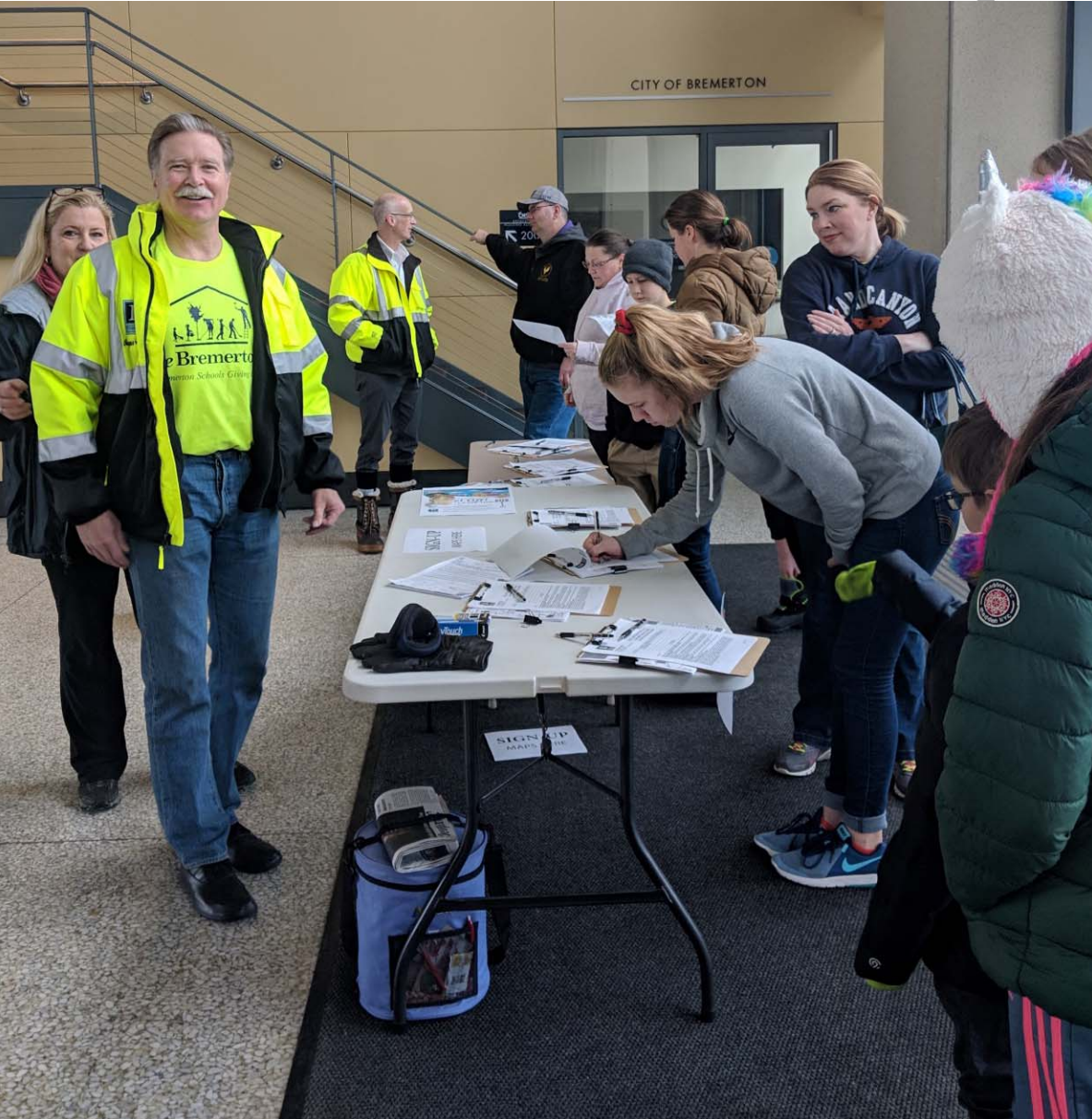
