



# Update on Level III Sexually Violent Predators Housing Proposal by Kitsap County

- Kitsap County has adopted interim regulations on where Level III Sexually Violent Predators (SVP) may be housed in the County
- The City opposes the County's proposal because the new SVP housing would be zoned near Bremerton neighborhoods, schools and recreational areas around:
  - Gorst
  - Navy Yard City
  - Perry Avenue Mall
  - Commercial areas along 303 corridor (near Fred Meyer, Lowes and Walmart)
- The City will be providing comments that oppose the County's interim regulations in their current form
