



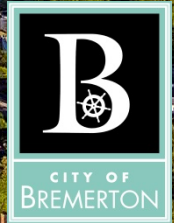

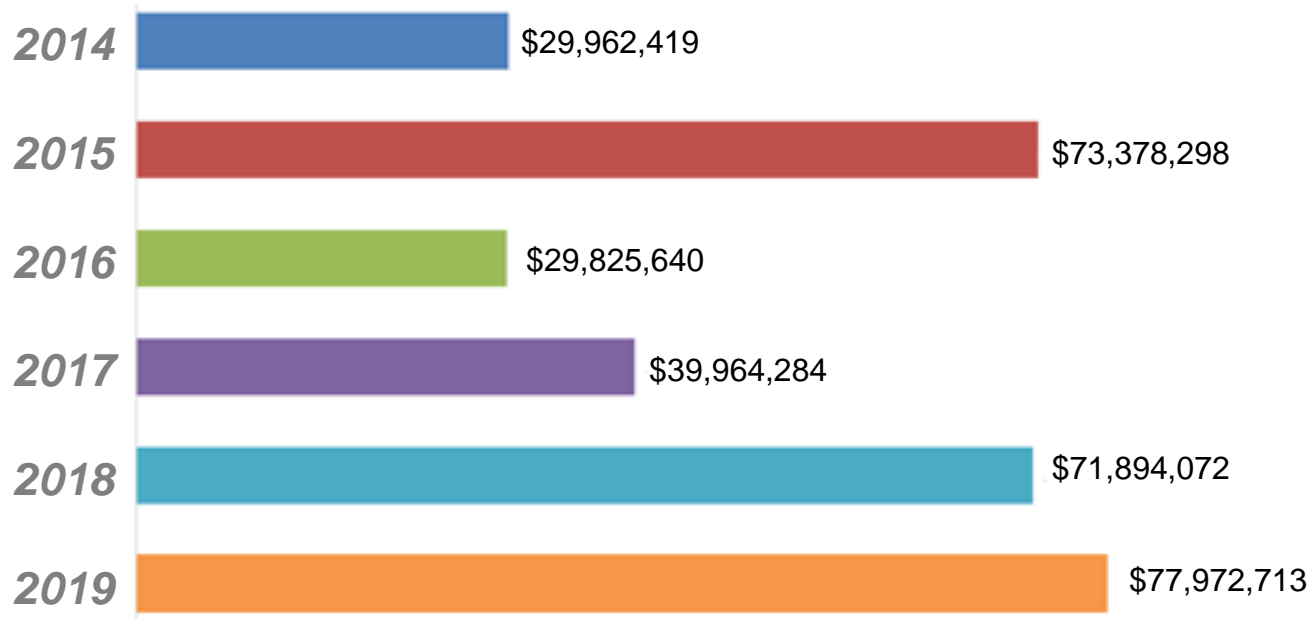

*Quarter 1-3 (January-September)*



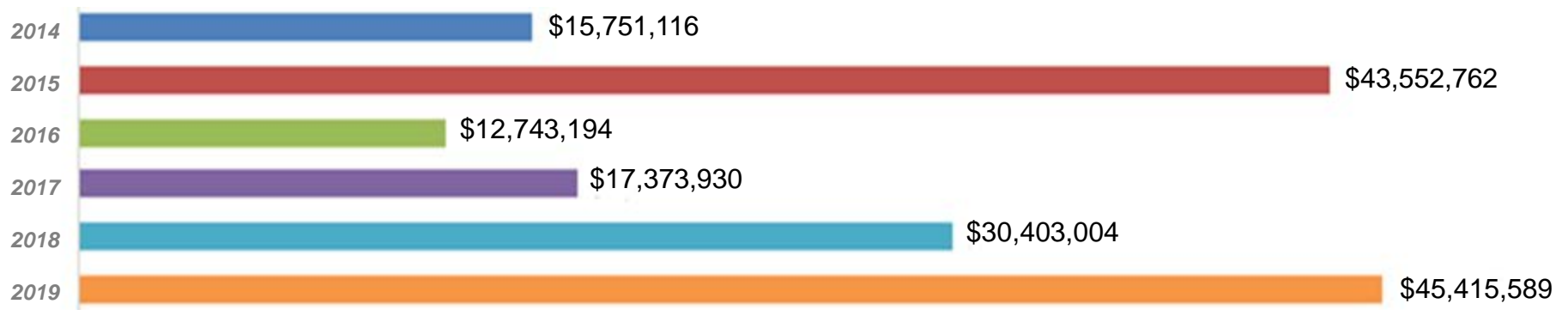
Nearly \$78 million in permit activity valuation issued this year with \$54 million in the queue! This is expected to surpass the highest year on record.
