- Replaced High Energy Refrigerators with Energy Star refrigerators
- *Residents will see at least a 25% to 35% savings in their heating costs*

Units will maintain affordable for low-income clients

Mayor Wheeler's 2018 Parking Goals and Strategies

2 GOALS:

- 1) Ensure that parking is available for downtown businesses
- 2) Limit commuter impacts on neighborhoods

Short-Term Strategies

(3 to 12 months):

STS 1) Establish Mayor Wheeler's advisory working group of affected stakeholders to assist in the achievement of the Short, Mid, and Long-Term strategies.

STS 2) Enact appropriate proactive parking enforcement:

- Utilize technology to improve enforcement by use of License Plate Readers (LPR's) and other smart device software.

STS 3) Establish the appropriate level of service for proactive parking enforcement including:

- Staffing
- Timing of enforcement
- Criteria to determine areas of emphasis patrols

STS 4) Establish appropriate parking pricing in City-owned lots.

STS 5) Evaluate data collected from proactive parking enforcement to revise strategies as necessary.

Mid-Term Strategies

(12-24 months):

MTS 1) Implement a residential-only permitting system to protect neighborhoods.

Ensure advance public communication by:

- Reaching out to Neighborhoods prior to any changes.
- Collaborating with business owners, employers and commuters.

Long-Term Strategies

(> 24 months):

LTS 1) Reduce demand for parking by promoting a shift from single occupant vehicle (SOV) trips to transit, pedestrian, and bicycling trips by:

- Creating a robust transit system.
- Creating City infrastructure that is multi-modal.
- Promoting park and rides.

NEUROFIBROMATOSIS (NF)

- Neurofibromatosis, or **NF**, is an under-recognized genetic disorder that can cause tumors to grow on nerves throughout the body.
- NF occurs in one in every 3,000 people and affects millions worldwide.
- NF can lead to blindness, bone abnormalities, cancer, deafness, disfigurement, learning disabilities, and disabling pain.

NEUROFIBROMATOSIS (NF)

- NF affects all populations regardless of ethnicity or gender.
- Roughly half of all cases arise in families with no history of the disorder.
- NF is more prevalent than cystic fibrosis, Duchenne muscular dystrophy, and Huntington's disease combined.
- NF has three distinct forms, NF1, NF2, and schwannomatosis.
