

Proactive Code Enforcement

In 2017 between January 1 and October 31, we responded to **684** issues; of those issues, **492** were closed by October 31st, leaving **192** open.

In 2018 between January 1 and October 31, we responded to **1042** issues; of those issues, **833** were closed by October 31st, leaving **209** open.

Additionally, Code Enforcement and the City Attorney's office are working on our first two dangerous or unfit building abatements using RCW 35.80. The initial hearings for both will be on November 26th.

Kitsap Lake Aquatic Invasive Species plan - \$30,000 in 2020

Northlake Way / Kitsap Creek Culvert - funding available in January 2019 for \$101K to complete a feasibility assessment, and preliminary design; funded by SRFB

NFWF Aquatic Weed Management Plan - \$20K
