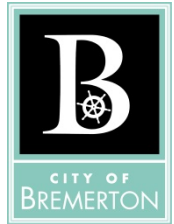

Cases per 100,000 per 7 days

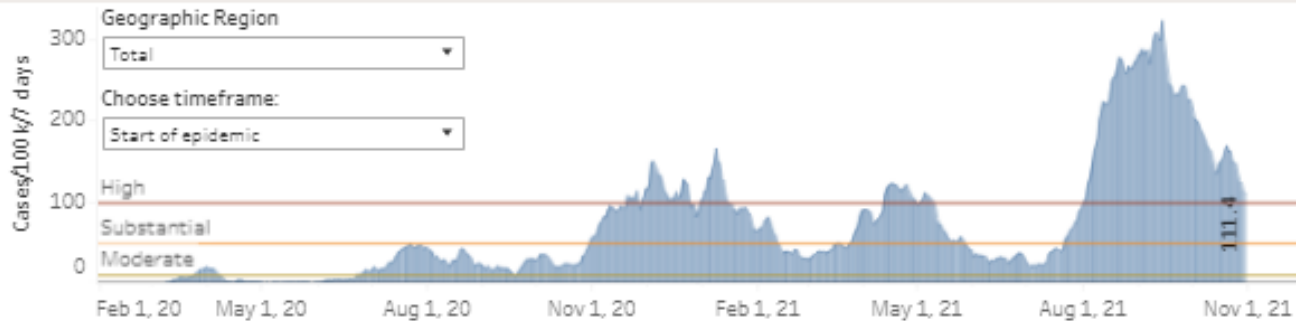

Cases and Deaths, Current as of 11/2/2021

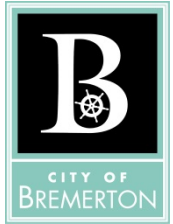

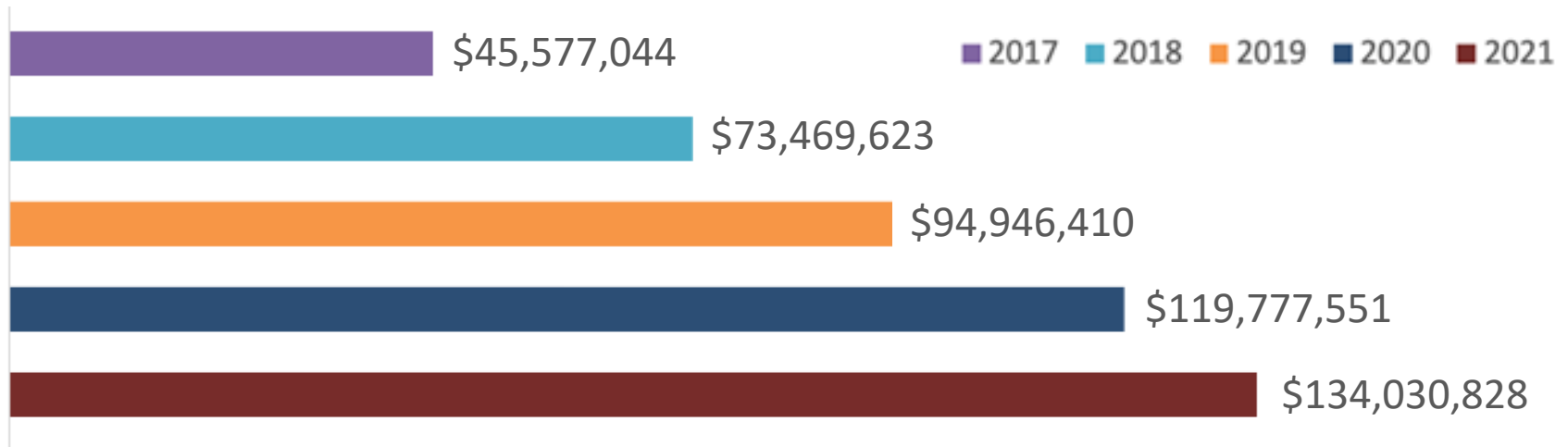


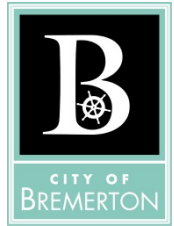
COVID-19 Update

- Kitsap County rates have been declining since mid-September when cases were at 322.6 per 100,000 residents (on Sept. 13).
- As of the most recent data, there were 111.4 cases per 100,000 residents. New hospitalizations have also been decreasing.
- While cases appear to be trending downward, it's important our community still take precautions and follow current health and safety guidelines.
