

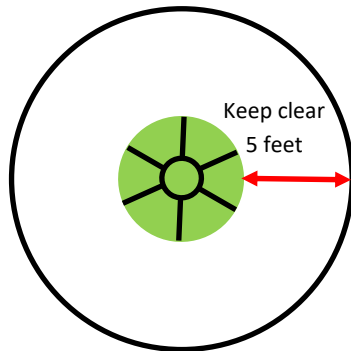
How to care for your

GRINDER PUMP

Do

- ✓ Keep the area around the pump lid clear

The area immediately around the pump lid (about 5 feet from the edge) must be kept clear and accessible for maintenance.



- ✓ Call right away if the alarms sounds

If the alarms sounds on the control panel (and the red light is blinking), reset the alarm by pushing the button on the bottom and immediately call the number provided on the panel.



Don't

- ✗ Flush or put down drains any of the following items:

- Rocks
- Glass
- Metal objects
- Diapers
- Seafood shells
- Plastic/latex/rubber objects
- Feminine hygiene products
- Paper towels or wipes
- Fabric items
- Grease, oil or wax
- Paints or paint thinner
- Kitty litter
- Strong chemical s
- Lubricating oil and/or grease
- Flammable materials
- Gasoline

- ✗ Try to service the system yourself

The City has contracted Correct Equipment to perform maintenance and repairs. When contacted, they will arrive within 4 hours to assess the issue. All you have to do is call!
