The public will hear information on:

- Design. The design will be reviewed in detail including the stage, lighting, and street furniture.
- Funding. Information will be provided on federal and other funding. If federal funding is received in early to mid-2022, construction could begin as early as this summer.
- Providing public input. This public meeting is the opportunity to comment before the design is finalized.
- Future public outreach and participation. Spring and Summer 2022 will offer an opportunity to engage on other parts of the project, including selection of art and interpretive signage.

- Substantial completion of the project is expected end of February (pending weather)
