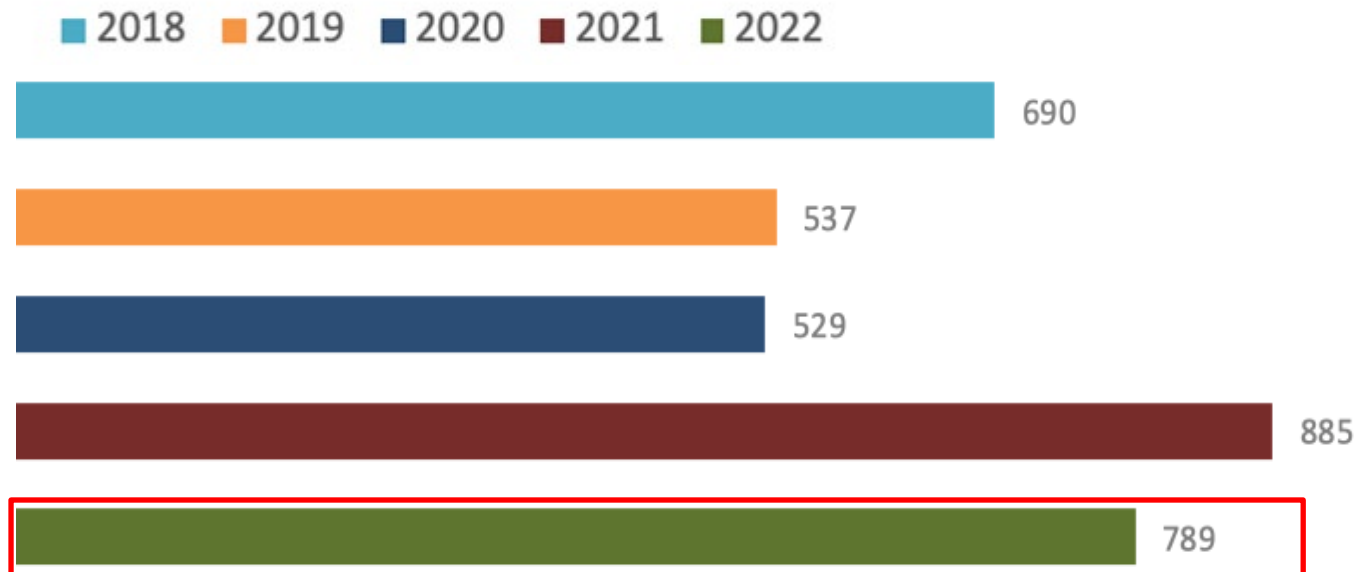

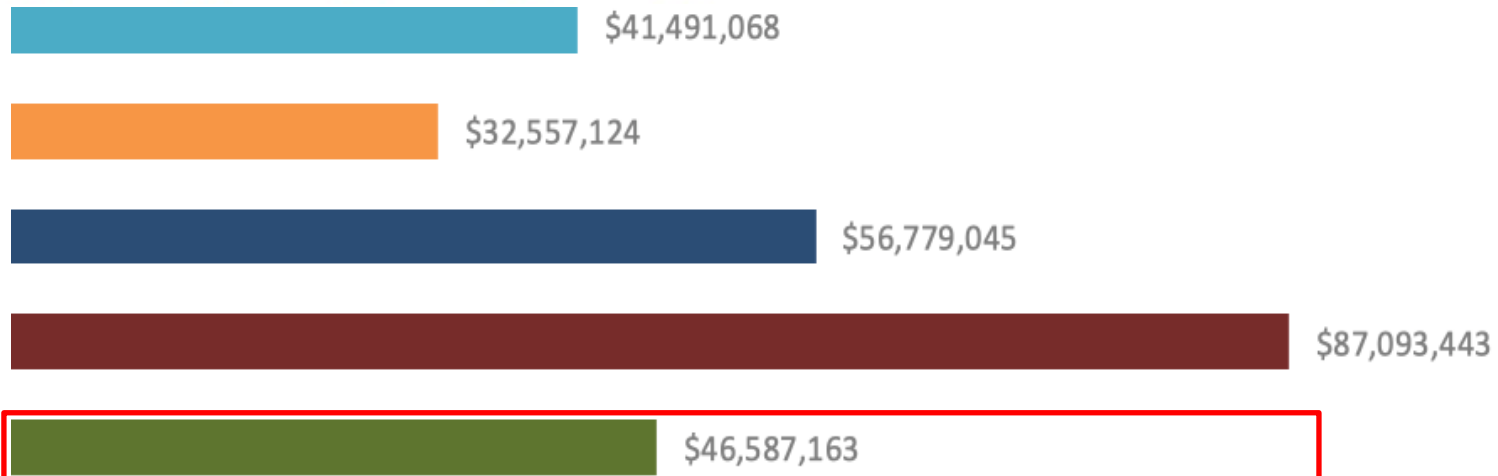
City of Bremerton Half-Year Permit Activity Permits Issued (January - June)

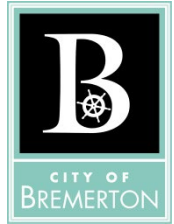




City of Bremerton Half-Year Permit Activity Valuation (January - June)

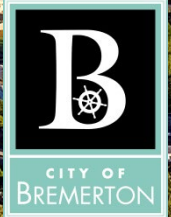

While the first half of 2022 has a lower valuation for approved permits than the last two years, the number of permits that we have processed remains high.

We have some high valuation projects that are in the review queue now.

These projects are likely to receive approvals in the latter half of this year, bringing our totals on par with (or potentially even exceeding) what we did in 2021!



REMINDER: WSDOT Warren Ave Bridge Work in July

- Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) resurfacing work on the span is currently scheduled for three weekends in July:
 - **8 PM Friday, July 8, to 5 AM Monday, July 11**
 - **8 PM Friday, July 15, to 5 AM Monday, July 18**
 - **8 PM Friday, July 22, to 5 AM Monday, July 25**
- Traffic will be reduced to one lane in each direction, creating expected miles-long backups
- Warren Ave Bridge drivers highly encouraged to:
 - Only travel if necessary and avoid discretionary trips
 - Travel earlier in the day or later in the evening when traffic volumes are lower
 - Use transit, carpool, vanpool or work from home or remote office locations if possible
